



## Subclass 407 Training Visa

The Training visa (subclass 407) became official on November 17, 2016 that is a revised visa from the original Subclass 402 Training & Development Visa under the policies & guidelines of the Australian Department of Immigration & Border Protection (DIBP).

#### The Training visa (subclass 407)

**Features:** This visa allows participants / candidates to;

- ✓ Take part in workplace - based training for a minimum period of 30 hours per week (120 hours per month) for the purpose to enhance the current skills & knowledge of persons who;
  - Were recently or are currently employed within the chosen occupation or field, or are
  - Within the tertiary study (current students in vocational education & training or university course/s)
- ✓ Participate in professional development within the current field of occupation within a training programme in Australia in combination with workplace – based training.

The Training visa (subclass 407) is for people who want to come to Australia on a temporary basis to participate in occupational training or professional development.

There are three types of occupational training (nomination eligibility types) covered by this visa:

- ✓ Workplace-based training required for registration
- ✓ Structured workplace-based training to enhance skills in an eligible occupation
- ✓ Training that promotes capacity building overseas.

**AAMS College** offers participants / candidates who are;

- (i) Current students enrolled overseas to gain work experience in Australia for periods of 6 months to 1 year after an initial period of their own course overseas & within a structured parallel training program so that the participant / candidate can then transgress back into the original field of study overseas for completion.
- (ii) Recent graduates, current employee overseas who have acquired basic skills & knowledge who wish to enhance their skills & knowledge working in Australia within a multi-diversified workforce can enjoy all the advantages that will enable professional development that will demand or command better opportunities when returning to the country of origin & seeking work within the chosen field of occupation.

**The Training visa (subclass 407)** will allow participants / candidates the following;

- Offshore** participants / candidates: -
- > Travel to & enter Australia after visa is granted
  - > Remain in Australia during the stay period granted (up to a Max period of 2 years),
  - > Travel to and from Australia during the stay period granted

- Onshore** participants / candidates: -
- > Remain in Australia during the stay period granted
  - > Travel to and from Australia during the stay period granted

**Stage 2** Upon acceptance of stage 1 – the following process will occur;

- 2.1 Employer** Matching your skill sets & qualifications against our extensive employer base will be performed
- 2.2 Offerings** AAMS will offer our selected employer base an offering of your qualifications with Introduction
- 2.3 Choice** AAMS selected employer base will make the selection on their own criteria matching process
- 2.4 Result** AAMS selected employer base will reply to acceptance or not
- 2.5 Reply** AAMS will reply to the candidate through **MARKETING407** where if the positive result will be placed forward to nomination to the Australian Department of Immigration & Border Protection (DIBP), or a letter of reason otherwise will be offered to the candidate.

**Stage 3** Nomination process to the Australian Department of Immigration & Border Protection (DIBP)

The nomination process is performed by AAMS as per the requirements under;

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**Stage 4** Immigration process with documentation including;

- (i) Nomination of sponsorship by AAMS
- (ii) Acceptance letter by the employer
